We lost a good man and a good friend on 11 April 24.

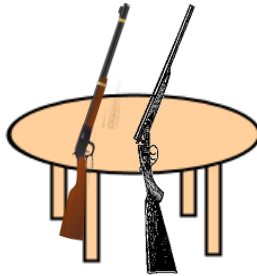
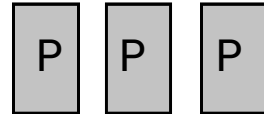

Stage 1

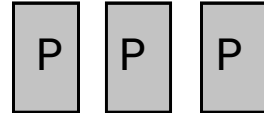
Rifle and shotgun are staged on the table, pistol are holstered. Gun order is rifle, pistols, shotgun.

Start standing behind the table holding the hammer.

Line: **THIS IS GOING TO BE A LOT OF WORK !**

At the beep: throw the hammer, if you hit one of the targets you get a 5 second bonus. With the rifle engage the rifle targets in two 2-1-2 sweeps. Make rifle safe and with pistols engage the pistol targets per the rifle instruction. With the Shotgun knock down the four shotgun targets in any order.

Stage 2



Round Count Ten, Ten, Four plus.

Dale and Gilbob must get their priorities straight. With winter coming things must be done quickly.

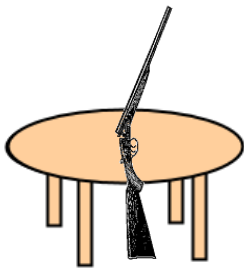
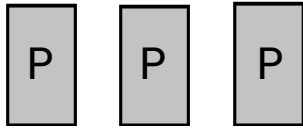
Rifle and shotgun are staged on the table, pistol are holstered. Gun order is pistols, rifle, shotgun.

Start standing behind the table at SASS default.

Line: **WE NEED AN OUTHOUSE !**

At the beep: With the pistols engage the pistol targets in two 5 round Nevada sweeps. Next with the rifle engage the rifle targets per the pistol instructions. Finally with the shotgun, knock'em down.

Stage 3



Round count is Ten, Ten, Two plus.

Dale and Gilbob have “taken care of business.” Time to relax, but after they had hung their hammocks, they hear something in the woods. Gilbob asks; are you snoring Dale? Dale replies; Never! It must be a bear!

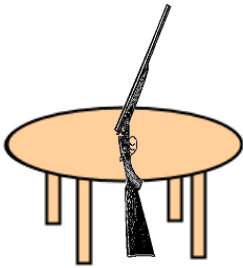
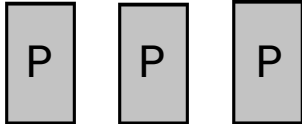
Rifle stage on right table, pistols are holstered, shotgun on table of choice. Gun order is shotgun last.

Start standing behind table of choice holding the bear with both hands.

Line: **IT MUST BE A BEAR !**

At the beep, if starting at the right table with the rifle, starting on either end, engage the rifle targets in a “Abilene sweep” That is R1, R2, R2, R3, R3, R3, R2, R2, R1, with the last round knock down one of the shotgun targets. Make rifle safe and move to left table and engage pistol targets per the rifle instruction. With the shotgun knock down any standing shotgun targets. Only targets left standing will count as a miss.

Stage 4



Round count is Ten, Ten , Two plus.

Time for dinner and the boys want some sea food, so they head to the local dinner. After looking at the menu and missing the low country, they decide to try mountain oysters

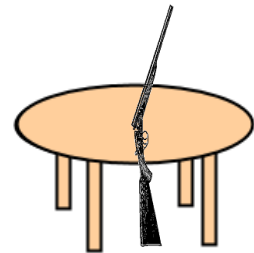
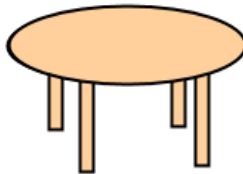
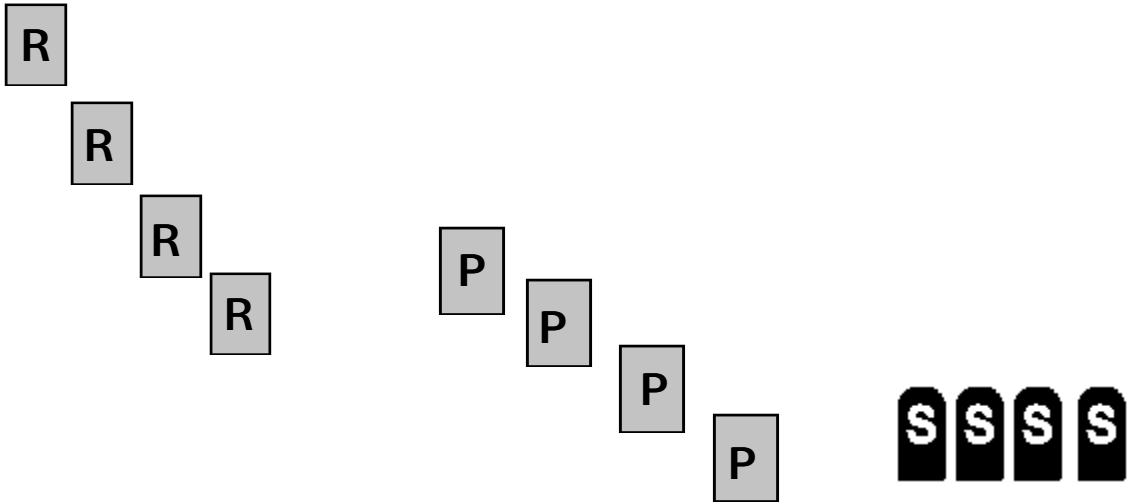
Rifle and shotgun staged on right table; pistols are holstered. Gun order is pistols, rifle, shotgun.

Start standing left table holding the fork and knife in hand.

Line: **THEY ARE A BIT CHEWY !**

At the beep: drop the knife and fork and with pistols engage the pistol targets in an Abernathy sweep for nine rounds: P1, P1, P4, P2, P2, P4, P3, P3, P4. Place the 10th round on any knockdown target. Move to right table and with rifle engage the rifle targets per the pistol instructions. Make rifle safe and with the shotgun knock down any standing shotgun targets. Knock downs made up will not count as misses.

Stage 5



Round count is Ten, Ten, Four+

It's cold in Tennessee. Sitting by the fire, Dale looks at Gilbob and says: I'm Freezing my giblets off!

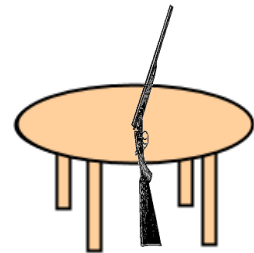
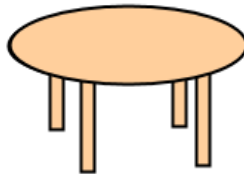
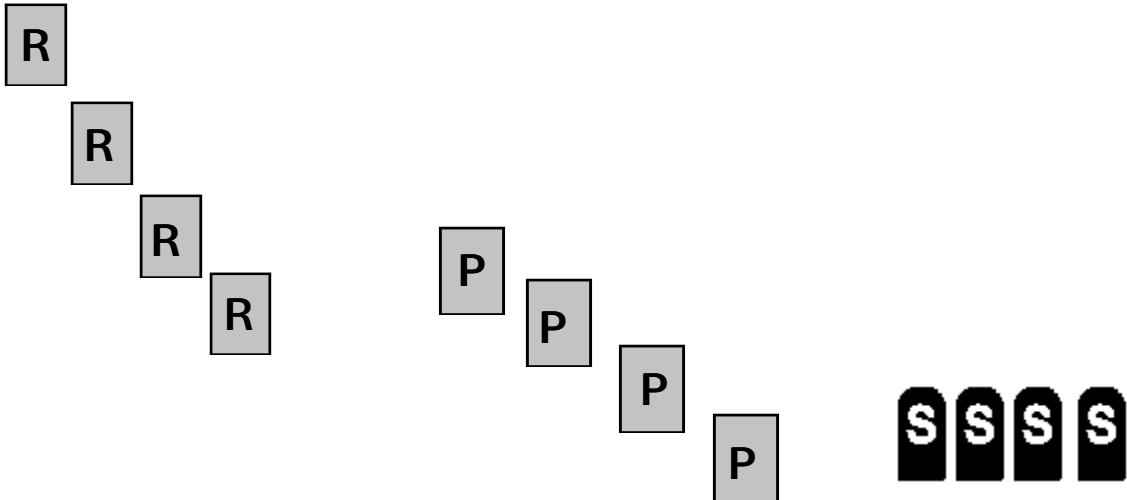
Staging: Rifle in hands, shotgun is staged on the right table, pistols are holstered.

Start standing behind left table, rifle in hands.

Line: **I'M FREEZING MY GIBLETS OFF !**

At the beep: With the rifle, starting on either end, engage the rifle targets in a badger sweep; R1, R2, R3, R4, R1, R2, R3, R1, R2, R1. Make rifle safe and move to middle table. With pistols engage the pistol targets per the rifle instructions. Move to right table and with the shotgun knock down the four shotgun targets.

Stage 6



Round count is Ten, Ten, Four+

Sitting around the gas station playing checkers with the locals, Gilbob has finally had enough. He needs to know something that has been bothering him and Lawyer. He asks the man sitting across from him: Did you people invent the toothbrush?

Staging: Rifle in staged on left table, shotgun on right or middle table, pistols are holstered.

Start standing behind middle table, holding he toothbrush.

Line: **DID YOU PEOPLE INVENT THE TOOTHBRUSH !**

At the beep: Drop the toothbrush and with the pistols, starting on either end, engage the four pistol targets in a Cactus Buck sweep: P1, P1, P1, P2, P2, P3, P3, P4, P4, P4. Move to left table and with rifle engage the rifle targets per the pistol instructions. Make rifle safe and move to right table and with the shotgun, knock down the four shotgun targets in any order.
